The Court previously awarded costs of \$700,084.79 on September 28, 2011 (see ECF No. 515) against the Blockbuster Subscriber Plaintiffs in the two actions that are not included in this bill: Pierson v. Walmart.com USA LLC, Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. and Netflix, Inc., No. 09-cv-2163 (N.D. Cal.), and Levy, et al. v. Walmart.com USA LLC, Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. and Netflix, Inc., No. 09-cv-2296 (N.D. Cal.)). This bill of costs, which pertains to the Netflix Subscriber Plaintiffs, includes the Netflix Subscriber Plaintiff's 50% share of the costs apportioned between them and the Blockbuster Subscriber Plaintiffs. See ECF No. 515 ¶ 3 (Order by J. Hamilton approving 50% apportionment between Blockbuster Subscriber Plaintiffs and Netflix Subscriber Plaintiffs). This bill of costs also includes some additional costs not included in the prior bill.
