ORDER DENYING MOTION TO QUASH AS MOOT

Re: Dkt. No. 533

On December 5, 2019, the court issued a partial judgment against Defendant Ningbo Sunny Electronic Co. Ltd. ("Ningbo Sunny") for \$50,400,000. Dkt. No. 518. Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 62(a), execution on the judgment and proceedings to enforce the judgment were stayed 30 days—*i.e.*, until January 6, 2020. On December 20, 2019, Plaintiff filed four applications for writs of execution. Dkt. Nos. 529-532. On December 23, 2019, Ningbo Sunny filed the instant motion to quash the applications for the writs on the grounds that the Rule 62(a) stay was still in effect. Ningbo Sunny filed an opposition to the motion to quash on January 6, 2020. Dkt. No. 539.

Because the Rule 62(a) stay has now lapsed, the court finds that the motion to quash is moot and denies it. The Clerk shall issue the writs of execution. Dkt. Nos. 529-532.
