19	Defendants Intuit Inc., Pixar, and Lucasfilm, Ltd. (collectively the "Settled Defendants")		
20	respectfully request that the Court amend the final judgment entered on June 9, 2014 (ECF No.		
21	936) between Plaintiffs and the Class and the Settled Defendants.		
22	1. Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 54(b), when adjudicating a case		
23	involving multiple claims or multiple parties, "the court may direct entry of a final judgment as to		
24	one or more, but fewer than all, claims or parties only if the court expressly determines that there		
25	is no just reason for delay." Fed. R. Civ. P. 54(b) (emphasis added).		
26	2. In its May 16, 2014 Order (ECF No. 915), the Court granted final approval of the		
27	class action settlements with Settled Defendants, dismissed this action with prejudice as against		
28	the Settling Defendants, and found final judgment appropriate in this action as between Plaintiffs

1	and the Class and Settling Defendants.	The Court entered Final Judgment on June 9, 2014 (ECF
2	No. 936).	
3	3. Having fully and finally resolved all claims between Plaintiffs and the Class and	
4	Settling Defendants, there is no just reason for delaying entry of final judgment with respect to	
5	these claims and parties, and the Settled Defendants hereby request that the Court enter an	
6	amended final judgment, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 54(a) and (b). The Settled	
7	Defendants have conferred with Plaintiffs, and Plaintiffs consent to this request. A proposed	
8	amended final judgment is attached.
