After the Court granted Defendants' motion to dismiss, Plaintiffs took an appeal. On appeal, the Ninth Circuit affirmed, and the mandate has now issued. The Clerk shall spread the mandate.

Of the member cases, some involved only claims that were dismissed, while others included various supplemental claims. It appears the purpose of consolidation has been accomplished, and the Court believes the member cases should now be severed. The Court believes those cases whose claims have all been dismissed should be dismissed, while those with unresolved supplemental claims should be transferred back to the transferor courts for further proceedings.

Counsel are directed to meet and confer, and to determine whether counsel agree with this proposed course of action. No later than <u>December 15, 2015</u>, lead counsel shall file a joint statement, explaining whether counsel agree, or if not, what they believe should

2	completely resolved and which have pending claims.
