STIPULATED ORDER


Laboratory Corporation of America and Laboratory Corporation of America Holdings (“Defendants”) hereby extend the Hold Separate Agreement between Laboratory Corporation of America Holdings and the Federal Trade Commission that was previously signed on June 25, 2010 and is currently set to expire on December 3, 2010 at 11:59 pm EST, which is attached hereto (numbered LX-0207-0001). Defendants extend the Hold Separate Agreement until December 10, 2010 at 11:59 pm EST, or – in the alternative – to extend the Hold Separate Agreement until December 13, 2010 at 3:00 pm EST if the Federal Trade Commission consents to having the relevant business employees (no more than 3 employees per contract and in no event more than 5 total employees) review in their entirety, beginning at 3:00 p.m. EST on December 10, 2010, all Westcliff Medical Laboratory, Inc. (“Westcliff”) contracts that are due to be accepted or rejected on December 14, 2010

and December 15, 2010 based on the Order Authorizing Sale Of Assets Out Of The Ordinary Court Of Business, Free And Clear Of Liens, Encumbrances, Claims, And Interests; Authorizing The Assumption And Assignment Of Unexpired Leases And Executory Contracts; And Granting Other Relief Pursuant To 11 U.S.C. Sections 105, 363, and 365, Dkt. No. 106. Defendants' extension will terminate upon a ruling before or on December 10, 2010 from a court of valid jurisdiction that Defendants may take operational control of the assets formerly owned by Westcliff.

The Federal Trade Commission and the Defendants agree to use their best efforts to have the Motion for TRO heard as soon as possible once it arrives in the transferee court after the transfer is completed by the courts.
